

# Wheeler Crest Community Service District

RESOLUTION NO. 19-04

A resolution of the Board of Directors of the Wheeler Crest Community Services District, establishing a adjustment for the cost of living that could affect the annual assessment for "connected laterals within the Lower Swall Meadows Water System.

WHEREAS, the Wheeler Crest Community Services District (the "District") is a public agency duly organized and existing under and pursuant to the laws of the State of California; and

NOW, THEREFORE, it is resolved by the Board of Directors of the Wheeler Crest Community Services District as follows:

- SECTION 1. Effective July 1, 2020 a cost of living increase or decrease of the annual assessment on "unconnected laterals" within the Lower Swall Meadows Water System will be implemented.
- SECTION 2. Implementation will be for five (5) years after which the program will be reviewed and will expire unless renewed.
- SECTION 3. The annual cost of living adjustment will be based on the annual change of the consumer price index (CPI-U) through April 30<sup>th</sup> of the previous fiscal year".
- SECTION 4. Each year, the adjustment will be reviewed for applicability and will be implemented each fiscal year beginning July 1<sup>st</sup> only if approved by the Board of Directors.
- SECTION 5. All affected parcel owners will receive a written notification of any adjustment to their annual assessment at least 30 days prior to July 1<sup>st</sup>.
- SECTION 6. The District has complied with all provisions as outlined by Proposition 218


